Florida PLT Expands Early **Childhood Program**

Last year, Florida PLT received a grant to further develop their Early Childhood Experiences program. Through this grant PLT was able to establish key connections in the early childhood community. Those connections have led to numerous workshop and conference presentations including: the North American Association for Environmental Education and the League of Environmental Educators in Florida (LEEF).







- ⇒ 500,000+ students will be taught PLT activities by the 1000 teachers trained in one of 52 workshops conducted in 2014!
- ⇒ 40,500 educators, parents, and students were engaged in PLT activities at designated PLT Schools, PLT Environmental **Education Centers. and at** professional conferences.
- ⇒ 15,000+ volunteer hours were donated to the program
